Only three days after its German premiere we are more than happy to host a screening of the award winning shortfilm "Lebanon Wins the World Cup" by Tony Elkhoury and Anthony Lappé. The film has won first price for short films both at the Warsaw Film Festival 2015 and at the Santa Barbara/CAL Film Festival in 2016. **Lebanon Wins the World Cup** is a documentary short film about war and football, told against the backdrop of the 1982 and 2014 FIFA World Cups. The Producer and Music Composer of the film and Lebanese Singer/Songwriter, **Allen Seif**, will present the film at our office in the centre of Berlin. He toured with the film through Lebanese villages and will offer us a wider perspective on Lebanon and its scars of civil war.

Allen Seif, also known as Oak, is a multi-disciplinary artist and singer-songwriter currently based in Beirut. With a BA in Music, an EP 'The Last Minute' and album 'On the Borderline (Between the Heart and the Mind)', Oak is well known for his insightful and thought provoking lyrics, pop hooks and evocative sound-scapes. Allen met Tony Elkhoury three years ago and set up a generative partnership collaborating on a number of musical projects before creating **Still See a Spark Films**. 'Lebanon Wins the World Cup' is their first big screen project developed in collaboration with New York-based director Anthony Lappé. **Oak** wrote and recorded the original score for the documentary as well as being the producer and the graphic designer.
