**Water is THE element of life.** Growing populations and processes of urbanization not only cause environmental and nutrition issues, but provide a serious challenge for water supply and wastewater management. In the arid zones on earth— which the Arab World is part of – the question of water supply is essential. With an average of 100 mm precipitation per annum the population, live stock breeding, and agriculture have to be supplied. Therefore, new methods for water treatment which preserve natural resources need to be implemented. German technologies in this field are very well developed and offer solutions on a broad scale.
